## **Gross Motor Development Chart** for Blind & Visually Impaired Babies & Children

Age Group	Milestones
Birth to 3 months	Holds head steady while being moved
	Lifts head up when on belly
	Elevates self by arms when on belly (totally blind or LP only babies may not do this until after they roll from back to belly)
4 to 6 months	Sits with some support
	Rolls from belly to back, from back to belly
	Sits alone steadily
	Pulls to standing (while holding your hands)
	Moves forward through crawling, creeping, or any other method
7 to 9 months	Pulls self to sitting position
	Pulls to standing position (using furniture)
	Sits down
	Attempts to walk (while holding your hand)
	Creeps forward on hands and knees 3 feet or more
	Takes coordinated steps (while holding your hand)
10 to 12 months	Stands alone
	Bends down to pick up object
	Walks sideways holding on to furniture
	Walks alone (3 steps)
	Walks alone with good coordination (5 steps)
	Pushes small obstacles out of the way
	Walks about house or yard independently
13 to 15 months	Moves around large obstacle
	Walks up stairs with help, down stairs with help
22 to 24 months	Squats
3 years	Runs, jumps, climbs
5 years	Easily walks backwards
	Hops on 1 foot
